

## **Do you know how to use your sewer?**

Only use your sewer and toilet for what they are intended for and dispose all other waste as appropriate.

### **You can only flush the following into the sewer network**

- toilet bowl water: toilet paper and human waste
- dish washing waters and laundry waters
- water used for washing or cleaning.

*Tip! Place a waste basket in your toilet, which makes it easy to dispose trash appropriately.*

### **The sewer is not a trash bin**

#### **Waste that goes into a trash can or container**

- solid and congealed grease
- small amounts of liquid grease or oil absorbed into a paper
- food waste
- fruit and vegetable peels and egg shells
- tea bags or leaves and coffee grounds
- plant soil
- liquid grease in a closed liquid carton/container/bottle
- diapers, sanitary towels
- cotton buds and cotton
- litter and sand from pet cages
- hair
- cigarette stumps
- condoms
- fibre cloths and hand paper
- sand
- medication
- paints, glue, varnish etc
- solvents, such as Acetone, turpentine, Thinner
- oil and any type of grease
- acids, such as battery acid, formic acid
- alkali, such as alkaline detergents
- pesticides

***Help us to keep our sewer network clean and avoid frequent blockages***
