PUBLIC NOTICE

Conditions on Posters and relating to elections, campaigns or events to be fixed on electricity poles

The following requirements or provisions must be complied with in respect of any poster relating to elections, campaigns or events to be fixed on electricity poles:

- a) An application or request with regard to posters must be lodged with the Office of the CEO in writing.
- b) Every poster must be attached to a board made of weatherproof material, in such a manner that it will not become wholly or partially dislodged by wind or any other means;
- c) No poster referred to in paragraph (a) may exceed 900mm in height x 600mm in width;
- d) a poster referred to in paragraph (a) may only be secured to an electric light or Low Voltage poles;
- e) No part of posters must be fixed at a height not exceeding 4 meters above natural ground level or pavement level as the case may be.
- f) Installation of posters on Medium or High Voltage poles are strictly prohibited. If in doubt kindly confirm with the Keetmanshoop electricity department;
- g) Posters will not obscure any road traffic sign, signal or mark;
- h) The safety of the public and road users is not compromised;
- i) Boards and Posters should not be fixed on any pole whereby a poster is already affixed to avoid possible conflict.
- j) The placement or fixing of posters may not interfere with any other services or service connections.
- k) One party may not remove a poster of another party.
- l) any board and poster contemplated in this section, must be removed by the person/s or party displaying it within five (5) days after conclusion of the election, campaign or event, failing which, the Council shall within ten (10) days after the conclusion of the election, campaign or event notify the relevant party to remove the posters within a time period specified, failing which, the Council may remove the posters itself against a fee per poster payable by the relevant party.
- m) The applicant or requestor must complete sign the relevant Indemnity form.

Council reserves the right to remove posters that pose a danger to the public and road users or fail to comply with the above provisions or requirements.
